## 2007 NOTICE OF RACE

for the

### 46th ANNUAL TUESDAY SUNDOWN AND FALL SERIES

The 46th ANNUAL GPSC Tuesday Sundown Series and Sunday Fall series is open to all seaworthy monohull sailing yachts. The Sundown Series comprise of TWO (2) Series of SIX (6) Races each. The Sunday Fall Series comprise of TWO (2) races on each Sunday Afternoon. All Races start and finish off Windmill Pointe Marina, located in Grosse Pointe Park, Michigan.

**SPRING SERIES: MAY 29 through JULY 3.**

**SUMMER SERIES: JULY 10 and 31, AUGUST 7 through AUGUST 28.  
(NO RACES ON JULY 17 or JULY 24)**

**FALL SERIES: 2 Races on Sunday SEPTEMBER 9 and 2 races on Sunday SEPTEMBER 16**

**MANAGEMENT RULES:** The races will be governed by the Sailing Instructions and The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, including US Sailing Prescriptions, except as stated herein; and managed by the Race Committee, which shall have the authority to establish the racing conditions and to interpret the racing rules.

**REGISTRATION:** All entrants **MUST** register for the GPSC 2007 Series Races. Both the 2007 Registration Form and the 2007 Registration Fee Form must be received for a valid 2007 registration.

**FORMS CAN BE FOUND ON THE GPSC WEBSITE.**

**WEBSITE:** The GPSC website (<http://www.gpsc.org>) has complete Sailing Instructions and Registration Forms. Both the 2007 Registration Form and the 2007 Registration Fee Form must be received for a valid 2007 registration. Race Results (subject to Protests) will usually be posted the day after each race. Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the GPSC website and the GPSC bulletin board in the north parking lot at Windmill Pointe Park.

**CLASSES and STARTS: 2007 SERIES CLASS SPLITS AND STARTS WILL BE POSTED ON THE GPSC WEBSITE AND ON THE GPSC BULLETIN BOARD ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE FIRST RACE.**

**COURSES:** Course assignments are set forth in the Sundown Series Sailing Instructions (S.I.'s). **THERE WILL NO CHANGES IN THE 2007 RACE COURSES. PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF THE NUMBERING SYSTEM OF THE TURNING MARKS.**

**SIGNALS:** The "F" Signal will be displayed whenever a freighter is in the vicinity. While the "F" Signal is displayed, the shipping channel is **OFF LIMITS. PLEASE NOTE S.I. #1 and #11 REGARDING GPSC's RESPONSIBILITY TO THE U.S. COAST GUARD AND ENFORCEMENT OF FLAG "F"**. GPSC patrol boats will be on the course for these race events to insure strict adherence to S.I. #1 and #11 by all entrants.

**AFTER the RACE: Preliminary race results will be announced and video (when available) of the evening's Sundown Series Race will be viewed** at Marge's, on Mack Avenue. All Racers, Club Members and friends are invited to attend.

Separate Sailing Instructions (S.I.'s) will be issued for the TUESDAY SUNDOWN AND FALL SERIES Races.
