NOTICE OF RACE for the 2008 GPSC Fall Series

The Annual GPSC Fall Series Races are open to all seaworthy mono hull sailing yachts.
It is comprised of:

**Two (2) Races on Sunday September 14, 2008 and two (2) Races on Sunday September 21, 2008.
First Warning signal scheduled for 1255 hours with first start at 1300 hours**

Races start and finish off Windmill Pointe Marina, located in Grosse Pointe Park, Michigan.

MANAGEMENT RULES: The Races will be governed by the Sailing Instructions (SI) and The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008(RRS), including US Sailing Prescriptions, except as amended by the Sailing Instructions. The Race Committee shall have the authority to establish the Racing Conditions and to interpret the Racing Rules.

REGISTRATION: All entrants **MUST** register for the GPSC Fall Series. **The 2008 Registration Form and a fee of \$20 (checks made payable to the Grosse Pointe Sail Club), must be received to compete in the Fall Series.** There was an opportunity to register on the Sundown Series registration form and those racers who paid the extra \$20 will be automatically entered into the Fall Series database for scoring. The Fall Series Registration Form is included herein for those who did not. Forward the Registration Form and Fees (payable to the Grosse Pointe Sail Club) to:

If you intend to race and the hour is late, call or email me (Chris Behler), and let me know you are coming to race. This will assist me in setting reasonable class splits for more enjoyable racing for all.

WEBSITE: The GPSC website (<http://www.gpsc.org>) has a copy this Notice of Race/Registration Form **and will have a copy of the complete Sailing Instructions for the Fall Series after the class splits are set.**

AWARDS: Handicapping is time on distance and high point scoring system is used for results with one throwout allowed. Flags will be awarded for first, second and third place finishers of JAM A and B. Race Results (subject to Protests) are usually posted the day after the races on the GPSC website and the GPSC bulletin board in the overflow lot of Windmill Point Park. Awards will be presented at the Annual awards party held November 7 at the Tompkins Center building, Windmill Point Park.

CLASSES and STARTS: Races include 2 JAM classes (splits to be determined based on registrations) with the first start scheduled for 1300 hours (1255 Warning). Starting class flag shall be code pennant 1 and 2 for starts 1 and 2.

COURSES: Courses are set forth in the Fall Series Sailing Instructions (S.I.). Standard JAM A (start 1) course is 5 NM and the Standard JAM B course (Start 2) is 4 NM. Marks are to Port. Start and finish are off the corner of Windmill Point Park Marina. The course extends roughly NE into Lake St. Claire.
